Project: Ruffled Serger Bag

This flirty Feminine purse features ruffles galore with serged edges highlighted using contrasting or variegated thread. The ruffles can be made using jelly rolls or 2 1/2" strips of your favorite fabrics. The bag is fully lined with fabric handles and bias trim.

Supply List:

- 1 Jelly Roll (will make 2 purses) or
- 12 2 1/2 " x 44" long fabric strips
- 1/2 yard fabric for base
- 1/2 yard fabric for lining
- 1/2 yard fabric for bias trim, handles and ties
- 1/2 yard cotton batting for purse base and handles
- 3 spools contrasting thread for serger rolled edge
 - (2 colors if using the wave rolled edge)
- 4 spools serger thread for gathering
- 1" Bias Tape Maker
- Serger with Rolled Hem capability
- Serger gathering attachment (if available)
- Sewing Machine
- Scissors
- Pins
- Tracing Paper
- Tracing Wheel
- 1 spool all purpose thread for construction
- 505 or Quilt Basting spray
- Serged Satchel Pattern (available at Mel's)
