



Mel's Sewing Service - Specialty Class Project: Starshine Quilt

Join Karen as she teaches you all the basics and assists you in advancing your quilting knowledge. This session's quilt is a lot easier than it looks. You only have to keep track of one big block to end up with stars and two secondary designs. This class has something to offer everyone – from a true beginner to a seasoned quilter.

Supply List:

1. Starshine Pattern (available at Mel's)
2. Fabric: per pattern for size you would like to make. The model is the lap size.
 - Be careful to have enough contrast between chain, background and star fabric or the stars will not stand out.
 - No need to purchase batting and backing at this time unless you think what you would like for you back might be gone if you wait. I would recommend that you do buy binding fabric now.
3. Sewing machine - clean and oiled.
4. New needle - my choice Microtex sharp 80/12
5. Bernina owners - patchwork foot # 37, or 1/4" foot for your machine
6. Thread to blend with fabric choice - I prefer cotton 40 or 50 wt.
7. Rotary cutter (with new blade)
8. Cutting mat
9. 6 1/2" x 24" ruler
10. Tape measure
11. Scissors, straight pins and any other basic sewing supply you think you might need
12. Paper and pencil handy to take notes
