Project: Baby Lock Foot Class

Supply List:

Feet to bring to class (if you do not have a particular foot you can purchase it at class):

- Blindhem Foot
- Beading Foot
- Cording Foot
- Elastic Foot
- Lace Foot
- Ruffling Foot
- Belt Loop Folder

Threads:

- Polyester Serger thread
- Wooly Nylon,
- Jean stitch thread,
- Pearl Crown Rayon

Fabric Strips:

- 4 cotton strips 4" x 16"
- 4" x 12" strip of cotton
- 4" x 10" bias strip of cotton fabric
- 2 x 4" x 10" lightweight to medium weight fabric
- 1 strip 3" x 10" of heavy medium to heavy weight cotton
- 5 strips 3" x 10" medium weight fabric
- 1 1/2 x 10" wide bias strip
- 3" x 10" strip of cotton fabric
- 4" x 14" strip medium to heavy weight fabric
- 2-3" x 10" strips of fabric or non-wired craft ribbon
- 5 x 10" strip light weight to medium weight fabric
- bias strips 7/8" x 10" (very important to be exactly 7/8")

Misc Items:

- String beads (cross wound) 14" 2mm to 4mm in size
- 14" of rattail or heavy decorative cord no larger than 1/4" (6.4mm)
- 14" of cording up to 5mm
- 2 x 14" cording
- 14" Commercial piping (purchased) – made not more than 5mm
- 10" of 1/4" wide ribbon
- 14" of 1/8" wide ribbon
- 14" zipper
- 14" of 1/4" elastic
- 2-14" pieces of 2mm-20mm wide elastic
- 16" of 30 gauge wire
- 16" of 8 to 10lb weight monofilament fishing line
- 16" gimp cord or heavy buttonhole twist thread
- 2-15" pieces of 1/4" or smaller elastic
- 2-1" x 14" pieces of lace

Needles:

- ELX705CF or universal needles size 80/12

Suggestion:

Bring double the fabric requirements. This gives you the opportunity to try the different techniques more than once.
